From Gene:

What characteristics would I look for in a presidential nominee?

- 1. Encourages, even rewards advisors who are comfortable disagreeing or dissenting from the president's policies.
- 2. Asks "what can go wrong" with presidential initiatives/policies (unintended consequences).
- 3. Can distinguish facts from value judgments.
- 4. Does not believe compromise is weakness.
- 5. Willing to measure and publicize outcomes of presidential initiatives.
- 6. Does not confuse causation with correlation.
- 7. Does not look upon the president as the "center of the universe."
- 8. Does not need constant reinforcement.
- 9. Can articulate and implement presidential policies.
- 10. Is an emotionally stable and mentally healthy leader.
- 11. Reads books.

How would I "vet" a presidential nominee?

- 1. Interview everyone who has ever worked for or was supervised by the nominee: housekeepers, lawn service providers, staff, the nominee's closest advisors, etc.
- 2. Interview everyone the nominee has worked for.
- 3. Determine if there is a significant difference between questions 1 and 2.
